Terms and Conditions of GenAquatic Swimming Club

Fees:

Fees are inclusive of GST and provide access to Term and Holiday Program training sessions.

Forms of payment accepted are: cash, cheque (made out to Genazzano FCJ College), credit and bank transfer (Account Name: Genazzano FCJ College – Swim School, Account No. 84 557 2756, BSB: 083 004). AMEX payments will incur a 1% surcharge.

In order to secure a position term fees are to be paid by the end of the first week of each term. Failure to make payment may result in your child's squad position being offered to new students.

Fees are subject to change at any time without notice.

Family Discounts:

Family of three - third child receives 30% off*

Family of four - fourth child receives 40% off*

Family of five plus – fifth and subsequent children receive 50% off*

*All members of the family must be enrolling into the GenAquatic program. The discount will apply to the last member enrolling into the program. Discounts are based on the above set session fees.

If you are already enrolled in a term at GenAquatic, we will 'rollover' your enrolment for the next term. An invoice will be posted out to confirm your place in the program.

If you are enrolled but wanting to stop swimming, please call the Swim School Office on 03 8862 1064 to cancel your child's squad lessons. Notice of cancellation is required two weeks prior to the commencement of term, otherwise attendance will be assumed and an invoice will be added to your account.

If you are not enrolled but wanting to join, please call the Swim Pool Office on (03) 8862 1064 to organise a free assessment. We are able to take new enrolments throughout the term, session availability permitting. Attending an assessment does not guarantee enrolment – swimmers must meet criteria set out by the Head Coach to be offered a place in GenAquatic.

Dress Code:

Swimmers who enter the water must wear a cap with their hair tucked in. Girls are to wear a 1-piece pair of bathers or a training specific 2-piece.

Equipment:

Each swimmer is required to provide their own equipment at each squad session. Swimmers require a pull buoy, kickboard and a pair of flippers. It is also recommended that they have a mesh swimming bag to keep all of these items together. All of this equipment (including the bag and a GenAquatic cap) can be purchased either individually or in a kit from the pool office.

Equipment kept at the pool for training must be collected within a term of a swimmer withdrawing from the GenAquatic program.

Private Lessons:

No private lessons are available for squad swimmers.

Absence:

The office does not have to be notified if a swimmer will be absent from a single session. However if a swimmer will be away due to travel, significant injury or illness please contact the pool office on (03) 8862 1064 or email genazzano.vic.edu.au.

Swimming Victoria Membership:

Swimming Victoria memberships must be renewed each financial year. Failure to renew your Swimming Victoria membership will mean automatic removal from the GenAquatic program.

Codes of Conduct:

All swimmers must abide by the Swimming Victoria and Play by the Rules codes of behaviour. All swimmers must also abide by the GenAquatic code of behaviour.

Photography:

Spectators are prohibited from taking photos of swimmers in and around the pool, change rooms and viewing area. All digital devices are strictly banned in the change rooms.
