At Genazzano FCJ College, we believe every girl has the potential to make her mark on the world. We empower our students to transform the future through action and advocacy for social change. Today, 95 students received their VCE Certification from the graduating Class of 2024 at Genazzano FCJ College, including one student who chose to complete her Vocational Major. At Genazzano, we pride ourselves on providing an inclusive educational environment that empowers students to achieve personal growth and success.

We recognise that the ATAR rank a student achieves does not define them. We believe that every girl has the potential to make her mark on the world, to choose her own path and transform the world by taking action and advocating for social change.

Ines Brear is the 2024 College Dux achieving an outstanding ATAR of 99.8 and perfect study score of 50 in Mathematical Methods. Earlier this year, Ines was acknowledged for her exceptional performance in Theatre Studies in which she earned a Premier's Award. We congratulate, Ines.

Overall, our median ATAR was 86.85, with 4.3% of students in the top 1% of the State and 10.7% achieving an ATAR above 98. 39.4% received an ATAR over 90. We commend the following students who achieved an ATAR over 99: Ines Brear, Sienna Van Velzen, Yen Truong and Jessica Hayhoe.

Our Class of 2024 attained four perfect study scores as part of their outstanding commitment during their VCE journey.

15 students achieved a VCE-Baccalaureate, which recognises students who choose to undertake the demands of studying both a higher level mathematics and a language in their VCE.

The attitude and determination of our graduating Class of 2024 is reflective of what it means to be a Gen Girl – a young woman who remains positive and focused, approaches challenges head-on, has the courage to ask for help and take risks, collaborates with others and has the confidence to keep going, even when it gets hard.

These achievements are a testament to the efforts of our entire community. Parents, carers, educators, and school leaders have all played vital roles in supporting these young women throughout their VCE journey. Their guidance, encouragement, and unwavering commitment have been instrumental in shaping the success of this cohort.
